











Consequentialist Arguments for Vegetarianism

- Not eating animals avoids environmental damage and depletion.
- 2. Vegetarianism makes people healthier.
- 3. Vegetarianism reduces world hunger.
- 4. Raising animals for food causes animal suffering.

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Rights-based Arguments for Vegetarianism

- 1. People have a duty to look after their health (Fox).
- 2. Animals have rights because they suffer (Singer).
- 3. Animals have rights because they are "bearers of life" (Regan).
